NURS 102-970 Introduction to Professional Nursing Course Syllabus Western Kentucky University

Course Description:

Introduction to the nursing experience. Topics include nursing history, current trends, nursing in the health care delivery system, professional responsibilities, educational options, professional organizations, certification and licensure issues.

Instructional Methods:

This course is taught using a variety of instructional teaching methods. Students will have assigned readings and activities both inside and outside of the classroom. You are expected to work independently and attend the online course prepared.

General:

Do your best on your work and your final grade will reflect your best effort. You have one week from the date the grade is posted on Blackboard to discuss in writing any questions or concerns that you have. Assignment Instructions:

Quizzes and Critical thinking (CT) assignments:

There are several quizzes and CT assignments throughout the course. These assignments and activities allow students to apply the following skills: library usage, computer literacy, college level writing skills, debating skills, judgment and responsibility. Points are assigned to these various exercises. As noted in the grading section, the lowest score for either a quiz or CT assignment will be dropped.

Exam I and Exam II:

Comprehensive exams will be given. Follow the Blackboard instructions for completion of Exam I. You must complete the exam once you begin. Exam II will be a proctored exam in the WKU testing center. Follow the Blackboard instructions.

Final Paper & Presentation

- 1. Your APA paper will compare the health care system and the nursing education system in both the United States with the country that you chose. You will compare and contrast the two countries on several criteria. The criteria is found in the Final Paper & Presentation Blackboard site and is titled "Your APA paper should include much of the following information".
- 2. Visit the Student Resource Portal on Blackboard for resources and support related to the WKU Onlilne Writing Center. The writing center's address is http://www.wku.edu/online/srp/writing-center.php
- 3. The Nursing program writes in APA format. Your paper must follow APA format. Use your APA Publication Manual and the information provided in Blackboard. You must have a properly formatted APA title page, body, and references page. The body of the paper should be a minimum of 3 full pages to maximum of 5 pages. You will lose points if less than 3 full pages or more than 5 pages. Note: the title and reference pages do not count as part of the body of the paper.
- 4. At least 3 scholarly sources must be obtained and submitted with your paper. Utilize the WKU Libraries site on Blackboard to obtain appropriate sources/articles. At least one of the

- references must be a published in a professional journal as a research article.
- 5. Please save multiple backups of your paper on a jump drive, disk, and your computer. This will avoid unnecessary stress by having to start completely over if you lose your only saved copy.
- 6. Student work will be checked using plagiarism detection software. You will submit your paper through Safe Assign. Papers judged to have plagiarism issues will be given a zero. You must give credit to the sources you use in your formal APA paper as both in text citation and source on the references page.

Global Health Care Presentation

- 1. A power point slide presentation is required. The power point presentation is from the same information that you wrote in your APA paper.
- 2. You will prepare slides that include presenter notes for each slide. The expectation is to include the same information that you would present in a face-to-face class meeting. Power point with audio is optional but preferred.
- 3. Presentation style and graphics are expected to be appropriate for professional level presentation.
- 4. You will include in-text citations on the slides at a references slide at the end of the presentation.
- 5. A summary will be provided and will include your conclusions on which system is the best and why (U.S. or the country you chose to compare).
