Course Learning Objectives

This course introduces basic accounting theories, concepts, and principles used to identify, gather, summarize, and report financial information. Emphasis will be on the components and preparation of the four primary financial statements.

Prerequisite

Completion of general education math requirement.

Required Materials

- Financial Accounting: Tools for Business Decision Making (9th ed.) by Kimmel, Weygandt, and Kieso.
- WileyPlus access (the online portal that allows you to access an eBook, homework assignments, and other supplemental materials).

WileyPlus Registration

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Big Red Backpack

The Big Red Backpack program is the title of WKU's partnership with Barnes & Noble College for their First Day Complete initiative. Big Red Backpack is a course materials delivery program that ensures students have their required course materials on the first day of class and may reduce the costs of materials for many of their courses.
