

ART-130: TWO-DIMENSIONAL DESIGN

COURSE DESCRIPTION AND OBJECTIVES

This course will prepare students to analyze and solve visual problems using the Elements & Principles of Design. Students will learn key terms and concepts while experimenting with a variety of mediums and techniques. Activities will include assigned projects with individual and group critiques.

Deadlines will be discussed at the introduction of each project. One project grade lowered for each class day assignment is late. There are no extensions on deadlines. If a student is not satisfied upon receiving a grade on a project, he or she will have one week to revise it for reevaluation and possible grade change. Evaluation and grading of projects will be based on intellectual standards such as execution (e.g. completeness, professionalism), inventiveness (e.g. relevance, conceptualization), aesthetics (e.g. principles, clarity), and respect for the diversity of cultures and ideas. The course grade will be based on student work, ability to meet deadlines, class participation, quizzes and attendance. Students are expected to observe and interact with one another during critiques and work sessions.
